- Sharing cultures and exchanging ideas. A platform with diverse groups of students working on common problems.



Global gPBL at IIT Madras

- A 2-week program where students from SIT will engage in a combined **research topic** alongside with **IIT Madras students**.
- Students will learn and come in touch several equipment, analysis and characterization techniques.
- The outcomes are very appealing such as work that will suffice for a conference or a publication in an international journal.
